The Pargues Régaud circuit

A ramble, up on the right bank of the Truyère, with lovely views of the Entraygues Valley.


Departure: Bridge on the XIIIe Truyère

Leave from the C13th Bridge. At the West end of it take the Tarmac road that rises behind a house, in the direction of Bouissy. Follow the stream and the shady road up to the houses of Bouissy. Keep on up on the little road from which you have a superb view of Entraygues, the Cambeyrac dam, the hydro-electric plant with its pressure pipes from Lardit in the distance. You will see grapevines to remind you of the Bouissy wine.

At the third house take for 100 m on the right, the sandy track called "Chemin des Haras" and keep going up till you reach the tarmac road. At the end of it take the way that immediately descends on the left. (Pargues is highen up, on the right). Keep going down on the little road between the pine trees, you pass the Ruisseau de La Coste (Coste stream), that flows lower down, on your left. * Go left here through a field, to reach Condat Haut.

<u>*Alternative</u>: To reach the main 920 road to Aurillac and follow it on the left up to The Belvedere that overlooks Entraygues from the Belvedere you will have to retrace your steps:

From Condat Haut, go down left for 200 m, then take a little path sharply rising, on the right. Keep going for 1km through the wood. Once on the little tarmac road of Bouissy go straight on the D 920 (Aurillac road). Bear left to get back to the Pont de Truyère.
