The Couesque Catchment


GR of Camin d'Olt. 904. Before reaching it fork right towards La Roque for 100 m to come back to the delightful views of Truyère Valley and Couesque dam). Fork left towards the D Izaguette and Le Lucadou. Keep going to the Lacassagne farm junction (for the bitumen track in the Lacassagne direction, leaving on the right, the directions On a very pleasant little road keep rising for 1.5 km. At the first crossroad take

down towards the valley before coming out to the little road coming from La right, then left to pass through pastures and a wood of chestnut trees and to go village of Valon and its castle that stands out on the horizon). At the last house go Continue to La Roque then, still on the right towards Le Couderc (view of the

overlooking the lake. After the farm go straight on along a very pleasant earthy path up to Le Lucadou the well-kept traditional buildings). Continue towards Le Rousty and Thely Leave the GR and follow the road on the right up to the farm of de Lax (note

old track, bordered by low walls and fruit trees, towards the dam - after having magnificently renovated hamlet extending along the banks of the lake. Follow an 📂 Keep going, above the Truyère as far as Izaguette. Bear left through the

> to the dam by a wide earthy track passed the pressure pipeline that brings water from the Goul catchment. Come back
